In the women's events Katherine Purcell, City of Leeds and Lisa Dobson, Halifax topped the medal table with five titles to their credit. They were closely followed by Sally Shields, Deborah Crossland and Carolyn Irvine, Boro of Kirklees and Kristy Davis, East Leeds all with four titles.
